Rules, Regulations & General Information

The GSDHJA championship horse show is run in accordance with the rules and specifications of the GSDHJA guidelines and the current USHJA Equestrian rulebook. A Show Steward shall be on the grounds.

Conditions of entry: Each horse entered for competition shall be subject to the control of the horse show management. However, the show management shall, in no case, be responsible for any personal injury or property damage caused to or by the horse. Each exhibitor, in entering the horse show, releases the horse show management, the Del Mar Fairgrounds, GSDHJA, the AHSA, and their respective directors and employees from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage arising out of the exhibitor's attendance at the horse show management, the Del Mar Fairgrounds, GSDHJA, the AHSA, and their respective directors and employees from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage arising out of the exhibitor's horse(s). Each exhibitor shall hold the horse show management, the Del Mar Fairgrounds, GSDHJA, the AHSA, and their respective directors and employees free, clear, and harmless from any and all claims and demands whatsoever for personal injury or property damage arising out of the exhibitor's attendance at the horse show. Each exhibitor is advised that he/ she is participating in an inherently dangerous sport, which is subject to the possibility of serious property damage, personal injury or death. By participating in the horse show and in such sport, each exhibitor assumes the risk of all such injury or loss. By entering the horse show, each exhibitor acknowledges and consents to the above stated conditions.


Entries and Late Entries: Entries must be submitted online by SEPTEMBER 25th. Online entries may be submitted at www.showgroundslive.com. Returned checks will incur a \$50 penalty. Entries received after due date will incur a \$100 fee.

RDNE: There will be a \$10 fee assessed for each class a rider rode in but was not entered, which shall be double the regular entry fee. **Cross Entries:** Breaking cross entry restrictions shall result in a forfeit of prizes and points in the lower division. Additionally, riders may be charged for the cost of the awards distributed if they cannot be returned in usable condition

Refunds, Adds, and Scratches: Stall fees and nomination fees are NON-REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CONDITIONS. Stall fee may be transferred to a new entry, but nomination fee is forfeited with scratch. **Scratches** will be allowed, and refunds given, for **non-pointed classes** (classes that do not count towards year-end awards) if scratch is completed by 6pm the day prior to when the class is scheduled to run. Scratches for **pointed classes** are non-refundable after the close of entries, unless cancelled by show management, or unless a statement signed by a veterinarian (or medical doctor for junior/amateur riders) is submitted stating that the horse (rider) is unable to perform in the classes entered prior to the start of the show/class. If you fail to scratch the class altogether you will be charged the full class fee. **Adds** submitted after the close of entries will be assessed a \$5 fee per class.

Responsibility: All Owners and Exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees, to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly. The Del Mar Fairgrounds may impose a minimum \$100 fine on any party failing to: remove bark, grass, framing or decorations; put turn-off valve or nozzle on hose end; turn off barn lights during day.

Management: The Horse Show Management and the GSDHJA Executive Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident at the Show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. The Horse Show Management, GSDHJA and their decision to be final shall decide all questions not covered in these Regulations. The Horse Show Management and GSDHJA, reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes without claim for damages; to change any course; to cancel or combine rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule.

Monday, October 2nd Set up day- tack rooms, set ups, feed, bedding, etc NO HORSES ALLOWED

Tuesday, October 3rd 8:00- 6:00 Horses allowed to move in. Stable gate will be open from 8:00- 6:00 ONLY. No trailers allowed to come through Solana Gate. HORSES MUST STAY BACK IN THE BARNS- NO LUNGING/RIDING

> Wednesday October 4th 8:00- Noon Horses allowed to move in

All horses entering the show grounds <u>must</u> have documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior. <u>All</u> <u>health documents must be sent BEFORE horses arrival and on or before October 3rd.</u> Horses may only move in during the times above. Stable gate security will be confirming all health documents.

Veterinarian Declaration Letter

A letter from your veterinarian specifically declaring that the horses listed are not demonstrating any signs of EHV-1 or Vesicular Stomatitis (VS), have not had any known exposure to EHV-1 or VS in 21 days, and are not coming from a property with known EHV-1 or VS positive cases. The letter must also state that the horses listed above have been in good health with no sign of infectious disease, and have not had a fever above 101.5° within the last 14 days. <u>All horses must be listed by the show</u> <u>name listed on their entry.</u>

Signed vaccination record from your veterinarian. See next page for USEF vaccination record.

<u> Class Specifications</u>

MAIDEN LIMIT NOVICE EQUITATION CLASSES

Maiden Eq – Open to jr/am riders who <u>have not won a blue ribbon in equitation</u> Novice Eq – Open to jr/am riders who <u>have not won 3 blue ribbons in equitation</u> Limit Eq – Open to jr/am riders who <u>have not won 6 blue ribbons in equitation</u>

Open Equitation classes, medal classes, Green Rider Equitation and the M/N/L equitation classes count towards your status. Wins in equitation classes that are run in conjunction with Crossrails and Short/Long Stirrup do not count towards your M/N/L status.

Wins in eq over fences count against your flat eq status, but wins on the flat do not count towards your over fences status. If you have won 4 blue ribbons over fences, your are ineligible to ride in maiden or novice eq flat or over fences *even* if you have never won a flat eq class.

If you have won your way out of one of the categories during this show season, but BEGAN the show season eligible for that category, you can still compete in that category at the Championship show.

Don't remember how many times you won? Look up your show record (or your clients) on <u>www.horseshowtime.com</u>. You can't look it up on the GSDHJA site as we only track Open Equitation points and not M/N/L points. PLEASE DO NOT GUESS!! The M/N/L equitation classes are *infamous* for creating controversy at shows when riders compete in a section that they were not eligible for!

MAIDEN EQUITATION OVER FENCES- All ages to jump 2' NOVICE EQUITATION OVER FENCES- 11 & U to jump 2', all other age groups to jump 2'3 LIMIT EQUITATION OVER FENCES- 11& U to jump 2'3, all other age groups to jump 2'6

OPEN EQUITATION

All over fences and flat classes to run in the Grandstand Arena

EQUITATION OVER FENCES 11 & U- To jump fences 2'3 EQUITATION OVER FENCES 12-14- To jump fences 2'6 EQUITATION OVER FENCES 15-17- To jump fences 2'9 EQUITATION OVER FENCES 18 & over- To jump fences 2'9

OPEN EQUITATION CHALLENGE-

Open to Professionals, Amateurs & Juniors. To jump fences 2'9. Top 15 return for 2nd round. Scores from 1st round carry into 2nd round. Additional testing of top 4-6 riders at judge's discretion. To compete, Pros must have riders competing at championship show. Last season's champion must sit out this season.

Hunter Classes

WALK/TROT DIVISION

Judged at the walk/trot. In eq over rails class, rider to two point over rails (1 x around) & post the trot in between, with diagonals to count around corners but not between rails. Riders may not cross-enter into any other divisions at same show. Riders who have competed in classes requiring canter for more than 1 season are not eligible to ride in Walk/Trot.

CROSSRAIL HUNTERS

To jump fences 1'o. Simple changes of lead will NOT be penalized. Riders competing in the Crossrail 2x around classes may also ride in Crossrail course classes, but may not cross enter into Short/ Long Stirrup. Riders competing in Short/ Long stirrup are only allowed to enter the Crossrail course classes. Riders may not cross enter into any division with fences 2'3 or higher. Riders who have competed at 2'3 or above are not eligible to ride in Crossrails.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTERS & EQ - 12 & under

LONG STIRRUP HUNTERS & EQ - 13 & over

To jump fences 1'6-2'0,w/0 oxers. Riders may not cross enter into pony hunters, or any division with fences 2'6 or higher. Riders who have competed at 2'6 or above are not eligible to ride Eq portions of Short/Long Stirrup. Riders may compete on multiple horses in Hunter O/F classes, but will earn GSDHJA year end points only on highest placing ride per class.

PLEASURE HORSES

Open to riders 11& under, 12-14, 15-17, and 18 & over. Horses to be judged on flat. (No qualifying needed)

GREEN RIDER HUNTERS & EQ- 12 & U, 13-17, 18 & O- to jump fences 2'3". Riders may not cross enter into any division w/ fences 2'9 or higher. Riders may compete on multiple horses in Hunter Over Fences classes, but will earn GSDHJA year end points only on highest placing ride per class. Riders who have competed at 2'9 or above are not eligible to ride in the Equitation portions of this division. Riders over age of 40 may compete in all portions, but only if they no longer compete at 2'9 or over.

PONYHUNTERS - 17 & under

To jump fences 2'3 (small and medium ponies) or 2'6 (large ponies)

LOW CHILDRENS HUNTERS - 13 & under, 14-17 & LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS

To jump fences 2'6. Riders may not cross enter into any hunter division with fences 3'0 or higher, or jumper division with fences 1.0m or higher.

CHILDREN'S/ADULTAMATEUR HUNTERS

To jump fences 2'9. Riders may not cross enter into any hunter division with fences 3'3 or higher, or jumper division with fences 1.10m or higher.

MODIFIED JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTERS

To jump fences 3'o. Riders may not cross enter into any Jr/Am hunter division with fences 2'6 or less

JUNIOR/AMATEUR WORKING HUNTERS

To jump fences 3'3. Riders may not cross enter into any Jr/Am hunter division with fences 2'9 or less or jumper division with fences .80m or less

<u>Class Specifications</u> Open Hunter Classes

BABY GREEN HUNTERS

Fences 2'6. Open to horses that have not shown 2'9 or higher prior to the current show year. Horses may not cross enter into any division w/ fences 3'3 or higher. Horses that moved up during year and competed at 3'3 or higher are ineligible to compete in Baby Green at the Championship Show

PRE-GREEN HUNTERS

To jump fences 2-9-3'o. Open to horses that have not shown 3'3 or higher prior to the current show year. Horse may not cross enter into any division w/ fences 3'6 or higher. Horses that moved up during year and competed at 3'6 or higher are ineligible to compete in Pre Green at the Championship Show.

LOW HUNTERS

To jump fences 3'o.

Jumper Classes Please Note: Hunt Coats and traditional colored breeches are required for all Jumper classes.

.60m JUMPERS

Fences .6m (2'), with no oxers or combinations. Open to all junior & adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into any division w/ fences .80/2'6" or higher.

.70m JUMPERS

Fences .7m (2'3"), with optional oxers & no combinations. Open to all junior & adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into any division w/ fences .90/2'9" or higher.

PONYJUMPERS - 17 & under

To jump fences .8m. Open to ponies & riders 17 & under

LOW CHILDREN'S JUMPERS - 17 & under, ADULT AMATEUR JUMPERS

To jump fences .8m with up to a .8m spread. Riders may not cross enter into any division with fences 3'3/1.0m or higher.

CHILDREN'S JUMPERS - 17 & under, ADULT AMATEUR JUMPERS

To jump fences .85-.90m with up to a .90m spread. Riders may not cross enter into any division with fences 3'6/1.10m or higher.

MODIFIED JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPERS

To jump fences 1.0m with up to a 1.0m spread. Riders may not cross enter into any Jr/Am hunter or jumper division with fences 2'6/.8m or under (except Pony Hunters/Jumpers).

JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPERS

To jump fences 1.10m with up to a 1.10m spread. Riders may not cross enter into any Jr/Am hunter or jumper division with fences 3'0/.90m or under except for the Hunter Derby (except Pony Hunters/Jumpers).

.90m OPEN JUMPERS

Fences up to .90m(3') w/ up to a .90m spread 1.0 OPEN JUMPERS Fences up to 1.0m (3'3") w/ up to a 1.0m spread 1.10 OPEN JUMPERS Fences up to 1.10m (3'6'') w/ up to a 1.10m spread 1.20m OPEN JUMPERS

To jump fences 1.20m with up to a 1.20m spread. Same horse/rider combination cannot cross enter into .90m Open Jumpers at the Championship Show.

<u>Class Specifications</u> Special Classes

SPECIAL JUMPERS

Open to all horses and riders. Riders must wear a collared shirt, tucked in. Clear rounds will receive a ribbon.

GSDHJA HUNTER DERBIES

To be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and movement. First round is a classic hunter round with the top 15 returning in reverse order of scores for the second round. Second round is a Handy Round and will incorporate tight turns options for jump approach, and galloping or trotting a fence. In each round, judges' base score will be given, then one point will be added for each option fence jumped, up to a maximum of four. Scores from both rounds will be combined to determine the overall winner. Riders showing in the Crossrail, 2' and 2'3" Hunter Derbies may do **two** derbies following cross entry restrictions. Riders showing in the 2'6" Jr/Am, 2'9" Jr/Am and 3' Open Derby may only show in **one** derby.

GSDHJA MINI PRIX

Classes will be Table II, Sec. 2 (a) - Two Phase Competitions. The first phase to consist of 8 to 10 jumping efforts (with a time allowed) and the second phase (jump-off) of 5 to 7 jumping efforts. If the horse has no jumping or time faults in the first round they return for the jump-off after all competitors have gone in the first round. The jump-off order is the same order as the first round, taking out the combinations that did not go clear .If there are no clean rounds and a tie exists for first place, there will be one jump off, in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults. The use of a Time Allowed is optional in the first round. Entry into Mini Prix classes must not create a cross entry restriction with any/all other divisions rider/horse is competing in. Riders showing in the .60 and .70 Mini Prix may do both classes. Riders showing in the .80 and .90 Mini Prix may only show in one of the classes. \$5 add back with prize money distributed as follows; 30% for 1st, 22% for 2nd, 15% for 3rd, 10% for 4th, 7% for 5th, 6% for 6th, 5% for 7th, 5% for 8th.

HUNTTEAMS OF THREE

In order to be consider for an award, other than "most entertaining", teams must consist of a three horse/rider mounted team. Traditional criteria; performance, manners, way of going, and synchronization over final fence will count for 75% of scoring. Artistic impression will count for 25% of scoring. Jumps will be 2'-2'6". All jumps to be ridden one rider after another except for the last fence. Special award for most entertaining team. No gifts to the judges permitted. Riders may ride on a maximum of 2 teams and total of teams may be limited to 25.

Medal Final Cheat Sheet

<u>Stirrup Cup - 2'</u>

✦ ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrails or Short Stirrup Hunters

♦ NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Green Rider Hunters

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals:

Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You may only show in the 2' Graeme Dixon medal finals, you are not eligible for any other medal final

Green Rider Medal- 2'3"

◆ ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Short/Long Stirrup, Green Rider or Low Childrens Hunters or Jumpers. You may also show in the GSDHA Mini Medal during the season.

♦ NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrail Hunters or any class with jumps 2'9" and above

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals

RRequires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You may not compete in both the Green Rider Medal and the Mini Medal Final

GSDHJA Mini & AA Medal- 2'6"

◆ **ELIGIBLE:** if you show in the Green Rider Hunters, Low Childrens Hunters/Jumpers or Childrens Hunters.

NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrail Hunters, Short Stirrup Hunters or any class with jumps 3' and above

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals: Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You may not compete in both the Green Rider Medal and the Mini Medal Final. However, you can compete in both the Child/Adult Medal and the Mini Medal if you are eligible and qualified.

GSDHJA Flat Medal

 \star Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season.

Child/Adult Medal- 2'9

◆ ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Low Childrens Hunters/Jumpers, Childrens Hunters/Jumpers, or Modified Jr/Am Hunters

♦ NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrails, Short Stirrup, Green Rider Hunters or classes exceeding 3'3"

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals:

Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You can show both the GSDHJA Child Adult Medal and the GSDHJA Mini Medal <u>OR</u> GSDHJA 3' Medal if you are eligible and qualified. You may not show in all 3 Finals.

GSDHJA3' Medal

ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Childrens Hunters/Jumpers, Modified Jr/Am Hunters or Jumpers and above

NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrail, Short Stirrup, Green Rider, Low Child Hunters/ Jumpers

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals: Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You can show both the GSDHJA 3' Medal and the GSDHJA Child/Adult Medal <u>OR</u> the GSDHJA 3'3" Medal if you are eligible and qualified. You may not show in all 3 Finals.

Jr/Am Medal- 3'3"

◆ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Childrens Hunters/Jumpers and above

NOT ELIGIBLE: if you show in the Crossrail, Short Stirrup, Green Rider, Low Child Hunters/ Jumpers

★ Championship Show/Medal Finals: Requires you to have shown in the class during the 2023 show season. You can show both the GSDHJA 3'3" Medal and the GSDHJA 3' Medal if you are eligible and qualified.

<u> Eliqibility</u>

A-Show Rule

Trainers, Riders, and Owners must all be members in good standing in order to compete in the Championship Show. Horses and/or riders must have earned (1) point during the current show year in all GSDHJA Recognized classes in order to compete. There is no specific 'A' show rule for the 2023 Champ Show.

2023 Year End Prize Qualification

In order for a horse to be eligible for a year end award in a hunter or jumper division in which points follow the horse, it must have shown a minimum of 3 times in that division. In order for a rider to be eligible for a year end award in an achievement or equitation division in which the points follow the rider, they must have shown a minimum of 3 times in that division.

Championship Show Eligibility

 In order to compete at the Championship Show and/or accrue points towards GSDHJA Year End Awards, RIDERS, OWNERS (if different than riders) and RIDER'S TRAINER must be members in good standing.

2) In order to compete at the Championship Show in any GSDHJA Medal Finals, rider must have earned a certain number of points in that class during the current show season (see <u>Points page</u> under Medals).
3) In order to compete at the Championship Show in any hunter, jumper and/or equitation class horse/rider must have earned at least one point in that division during the current show season. By division we mean all of Short Stirrup, or all of Green Riders, so if you earned a point in Short Stirrup Hunters O/F then you are automatically qualified to ride in ALL the classes of the Short Stirrup division (i.e. SS u/s, SS Eq O/F, SS Eq flat).

Cross Entry Crossrails/Short Stirrup

At the champ show riders may compete in Crossrails 2x around AND Crossrails Course OR Crossrails Course AND Short/Long Stirrup. Riders MAY NOT Compete in Crossrails 2X around and Short/Long Stirrup. If a rider is competing in BOTH Crossrails 2x around AND Crossrails Course, then only the higher placing of their two hunter classics, hunter under saddle classes, equitation over fences, and equitation flats will count for year end points.

Green Riders & the GSDHJA Hunter Derby

Can riders competing in Green Riders can do the 2'6 section of the Hunter Derby even though the option fences are 2'9?

YES! GREEN RIDER HUNTER riders MAY ENTER THE 2'6 SECTION OF THE HUNTER DERBY. Don't forget that by competing in the Hunter Derby that rider would be ineligible to compete in Green Rider next season, per the <u>GSDHJA rules</u> that Riders also competing at 2'6 may only enter Green Rider if in their 1st season of showing 2'6.

Open Equitation Flat Over Fences

Can riders who compete in the higher hunter or jumper divisions can drop down in order to compete in their age group eq over fences?

The answer is YES! If you, for example, are 11 years old and compete in 2'9 hunter or jumper divisions, you can drop down and ride in 11 & under eq over fences (2'3) even though it is a height difference of 6" or more.

The reverse is not true though. If you ride in a lower H/J division (say long stirrup hunters at 2'0), and you are 15, you cannot compete in the 14-17 equitation over fences which jumps at 2'9. So for those of you who are competing in a hunter jumper division level lower than what your age group eq jumps at, the difference can only be 3", any more than that is a cross entry restriction.
